SEPTEMBER BIRTH FLOWERS

Just like birthstones, birth flowers are symbolic of the month we're born in, and each one carries a special meaning. Aster is the birth flower for September and the native birth flower is Gum Blossom.



Asters show their beauty through late summer and autumn, when many of our summer blooms may be fading.

Asters prefer climates with cool, moist summers and loamy soil that has good drainage. Plant in spring after the danger of frost has passed, starting with soil preparation by incorporating Seamungus and watering in well with **GOGO Juice** every two weeks. Once they are more than two months of age, you can start to apply **Sudden Impact for Roses** every eight weeks to ensure healthy plants that produce plenty of flowers.

GUM BLOSSOM



Gum Blossoms are a real spring treat creating lovely displays in September making them a great choice for native flower of the month.

Some of the varieties of flowering gums include Eucalyptus caesia 'Silver Princess' with large deep-pink flowers with bell-shaped gumnuts covered in a white mealy coating.

When planting eucalyptus trees, ensure to feed with a biological fertiliser like **Bush Tucker** to ensure strong root development.

PLANTING IN SEPTEMBER

Spring is in the air and if you are yet to do so, now is a great time to dust of those gardening tools and get back to gardening!

The soil will begin to warm up as our days become warmer, so think carefully about any new plants you'd like to add. A little bit of planning now gives you time to prepare for a productive season, including whipping the soil into shape prior to planting.

Condition the soil with Seamungus and water in with GOGO Juice for a boost of beneficial microbiology and to create a healthy base for optimal root development.

Additionally, adding a layer of Whoflungdung will provide the soil with plenty of organic matter for a well-structured soil, and will help to regulate temperature and retain moisture as the days get warmer.

Sweet potato

Like humans and animals, plants require regular feeding throughout the year – at least once in each season.

HEDGES

POTS

VEGETABLES






NEW LAWNS






NEUTROG POT GUIDE
